PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS: Each year over 500 Pennsylvanians die as a result of motorists driving under the influence; and

WHEREAS: An average of five Warren County residents die each year as a result of motorists driving under the influence; and

WHEREAS: The DUI Victim Impact Group was started in 1994 dedicated to reducing the incidence of impaired driving and the harm and destruction it causes. The Victim Impact Group began providing Victim Impact Panel presentations to DUI offenders in Warren and Forest Counties; and

WHEREAS: The Pennsylvania DUI Association was founded in 1978 as a nonprofit organization dedicated to highway safety. That in 2003 the Pa. DUI Association constructed a Victims Memorial Garden as a means of remembering DUI victims and educating the public on the impact of impaired driving. That in 2006 the Pa DUI Association constructed a Rolling Memorial to take the message to the people of Pennsylvania.

WHEREAS: On Saturday March 27 2010 at 9:00 AM a loving remembrance ceremony will be held on behalf of those who can no longer speak for themselves, for their families and friends and for those who will never forget; and to **“Take the Steps to Remember DUI Victims”**.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Warren County Commissioners proclaim Saturday March 27<sup>th</sup> 2010 as a day of commemoration and remembrance for all those whose lives have been affected by impaired driving and to send the message that we will always remember those who have been needlessly killed by impaired drivers.
